Site Readiness Checklist for Tank Deliveries

To ensure a smooth and efficient delivery, please review and adhere to the following site readiness guidelines before our picker trucks arrive.

Pathway and Access Requirements:

Ensure that the entire path to the installation site is clear of any obstructions, including vehicles, debris, or barriers.

- **Overhead Clearance:** The route should be free of overhead power lines, tree branches, and any other obstructions with at least 17 feet of clearance.
- Access for Picker Truck: Our picker truck requires a clear and accessible route, as well as a width of 17-20 feet for operation, including the extension of outriggers.
- **Reminder:** If a school bus can back up to the hole, there's enough space for our truck.



Hole Preparation:

- The hole for the tank should be pre-dug and positioned so that one face of the hole is open and accessible for the picker truck to back in.
- Confirm that the truck can back up directly to the hole without obstruction.



Final Checklist:

- √Is the pathway clear and accessible for our picker truck?
- ✓Overhead clearance of 17 feet is met?
- √Width clearance of 17-20 feet is met?
- √Hole is dug and ready with access?
